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關於我們 About Us

新界婦孺福利會由創會會長梁省德太平紳士於 1965 年成立，並於 1967 年正式註冊為非牟利有限公司。本會是一個以家庭為核心服務社會的慈善機構，旨在為基層家庭提供優質服務。透過屬下 10 個服務單位，本會致力於推動社會發展和進步，並努力構建一個以德立人的社會。

本會的使命是「以家為本、省德立人」。我們相信，一個穩定、和諧、有愛的家庭是利社會發展的重要因素，對個人健康成長起著至關重要的作用。自成立以來，本會一直與各方持份者緊密合作，推廣正確的道德價值觀，鼓勵人們相互尊重、關注社會公益、建設美好生活環境，以促進社會的健康發展和進步。

本會成立之初主要是從關心新界婦女及其子女的起居照顧開始，於荃灣開辦非牟利幼稚園，提供實際的支援服務，為農村婦孺舉辦義學及興趣班，育兒講座等。我們亦關心鄉郊地區長者的獨特需要，率先在元朗洪水橋區為長者提供基本文娛康樂活動及個人服務，主動舉辦多項義工服務、社區參與和關社教育，使長者提升個人能力感，改善社會對長者的形象，促進社會共融和諧。

隨著香港社會發展，本會服務趨向專業化，為普羅大眾階層興辦學校、幼稚園以提供優質學術及品行教育的同時，更帶領同學參與不同的交流活動，擴闊視野，培養學生學習獨立思考和成為優秀領袖人才。

面對社會的急速變遷，本會仍會以家庭為工作核心，為香港家庭每一位成員提供學習機會、德育培養、獨立思考訓練，並關懷弱勢社群。在各方的支持和努力下，本會積極開展教育及社會服務，並逐步擴展服務範圍至香港各區，將愛與關懷於香港各社區中繼續傳播，以達致建立團結融和的香港社會。

The New Territories Women & Juveniles Welfare Association (NTWJWA or Association) was founded by Ms. LEUNG Sing Tak, BBS, MBE, JP in 1965, and was formally registered as a non-profit limited company in 1967. We are a charitable organisation that strive to provide quality services to families in need with a core focus on family. Through our 10 service units, we are committed to promoting social development and progress, and strives to build a society that values ethics and morality.

“Rooted in Family, Built on Virtue” is the mission of our Association. We believe that a stable, harmonious, and loving family contributes is an important factor in promoting social development, and that it plays a crucial role in the personal growth and development of individuals. Since its inception, the Association works closely with our stakeholders as we are committed to constructing a society based on morality, emphasising the promotion of moral values, encourage mutual respect, promote social welfare, and build a better living environment, in order to promote healthy social development and progress.

From its inception, our Association was founded with the primary concern of providing care for the daily living of the women and their children in New Territories, we set up our first non-profit making kindergarten in Tsuen Wan, provide practical support services and organise free classes for women and children. We have also responded to the unique needs of the elderly in the rural areas by being the first to provide cultural and recreational activities and personal service to the elderly in the Hung Shui Kiu district of Yuen Long. We also actively organise a number of community services and educational programs to enable the elderly to enhance their sense of personal competence, improve how society views the elderly community, and promote social harmony and inclusiveness.

We provide more professional services with the advancement of our society. We have established schools and kindergartens for the general public to provide quality academic and moral education. We have also lead students to participate in various exchange activities to broaden their horizons and cultivate students independent thinking and develop them into outstanding leaders.

In the face of rapid social changes in Hong Kong, the Association will continue to focus on the family, providing learning opportunities, moral education, independent training. With the support and effort of all parties, our Association actively promotes education and social services, and gradually expands the scope of our services to more locations in Hong Kong. We will continue to care for the disadvantages to achieve a united and harmonious society.

歷史里程碑

Our History

1965

- 新界婦孺福利會成立，當時是一所位於荃灣寶石大廈的非牟利幼稚園，後經民政事務局各區官員及區內其他簽署人建議，改名為「新界婦孺福利會有限公司」。
- 首辦馬灣診療所，贈醫施藥，服務貧苦大眾。
- The New Territories Women & Juveniles Welfare Association was established as a non-profit making kindergarten at Bo Shek Mansion in Tsuen Wan and was later renamed as the “New Territories Women & Juveniles Welfare Association Limited” as recommended by the District Officers of the Home Affairs Bureau and other signatories within the local communities.
- The Ma Wan Clinic was set up to provide medicine and services to the neighbourhood.

The Cheung Chau Women & Juveniles Welfare Centre was established to promote cultural and recreational activities. This was followed by the establishment of a children garden (nursery school) in Ping Chau and a kindergarten in Hung Shui Kiu.

On the day, our units organise different family-based celebration activities to promote joyful interactions and communication among family members, creating the sense of contentment and happiness.

幼兒教育服務

本會一直積極培養學生的國家觀念，過去一年幼兒教育服務舉辦了多個推廣中華文化的活動，加強幼兒對祖國的認識；部份幼兒學校更將「中華文化」加入課程重點，配合多個中華文化主題，推動國情教育及建立幼兒國民身份認同。

本會重視教師的專業發展，除定期舉辦教師培訓以提升教師的能力；更鼓勵員工前往外地進行專業交流。本年度幼兒教育服務選派校長及教師代表先後前往澳洲、印尼、中國內地等地進行學術交流，了解最新的教育資訊，增廣教育視野。

本會更積極推動家校協作，與家長共同關注孩子的學習與成長。本年度五所幼兒學校成立第一屆「家長教師會」，建立家校溝通的橋樑，促進雙方的互動與合作，並共同籌辦不同類型的活動，支援家長及學生的需要。

小學教育服務

本會致力為學生提供多元和優質的教育，推動全人發展，提升學生的知識和技能。屬下兩所小學於校內均設有科學探索空間，提供與 STEAM 教育相關設備，讓學生透過不同形式的探索，培養觀察、解難及創作能力。學校亦善用課堂時間加入「跨學科」課堂及活動，引領學生結合各科知識發揮潛能。

學校提供全方位的學習機會，組織多項課外活動，更讓學生有機會走出課室，參觀社區、到外地交流，擴闊視野。本年度兩所小學分別舉辦或參與於上海、東莞、廣州及山東等地的交流體驗活動，開拓學生的學習眼界。

Early Childhood Education

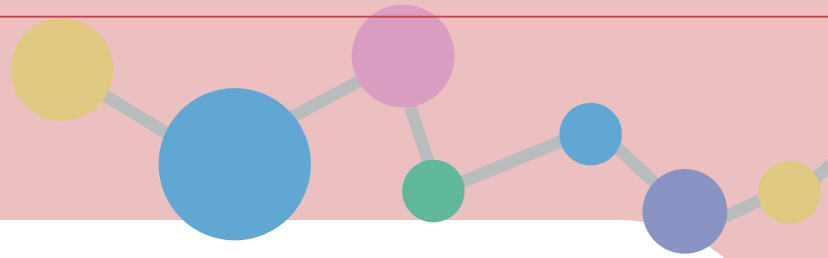
Our Association has been actively cultivating among students a sense of belonging towards our country. Over the past year, we have organised various activities to promote Chinese culture, enhancing young children's understanding of the Motherland. Some of our nursery schools have incorporated "Chinese Culture" as a key focus in their curriculum, aligning with various themes of Chinese culture to promote national education and establish a sense of national identity among young children.

We value the professional development of our teachers. In addition to regularly organising training sessions to enhance their capabilities, we also encourage our staff to engage in professional development abroad. This year, Principals and teachers from our Early Childhood Education Services were sent to Australia, Indonesia, and Mainland China for academic exchanges, gaining insights into the latest educational trends and broadening their educational perspectives.

We also actively promote home-school collaboration, working together with parents to focus on their children's learning and growth. This year, our nursery schools established their respective Parent-Teacher Associations, creating a bridge for communication between home and school, promoting interaction and cooperation between both parties, and jointly organising various activities to support the needs of parents and students.

Primary Education Services

Our Association is committed to providing students with diverse and high-quality education, promoting holistic development, and enhancing students' knowledge and skills. Our two primary schools, equipped with STEAM-related facilities, have established dedicated science exploration areas on campus. This allows students to engage in various forms of exploration, nurture students' observation skills, problem-solving skills, and creativity. The schools also make good use of classroom time by incorporating transdisciplinary lessons and activities, guiding students to integrate knowledge from different subjects to unleash student potential.



社會服務

社會服務部轄下柏雨長者鄰舍中心及長者社區照顧服務中心，致力為洪水橋的長者及其照顧者提供適切服務。本年度合共服務超過 30,000 人次。

本年度社會服務單位專注為長者及護老者提供多元化的服務，包括推行為期兩年的「賽馬會 e 健樂電子健康管理計劃」，提升會員對身體健康的關注；提供初步的認知評估、諮詢、服務轉介及擺設街站，強化認知友善的推廣；與附近鄉村代表保持合作關係，加強鄉郊宣傳；開拓青老群體，為青老提供多元化創新活動；保持對外合作，拓展資源提供多元化服務。單位間亦持續互相合作，加強暫託長者及其照顧者對自我健康管理的意識及實踐預防性行動，維持身、心、靈的健康。

The schools offer comprehensive learning opportunities and organise various extracurricular activities, allowing students to step outside the classroom to visit the community and participate in exchanges abroad, thereby broadening their horizons. This year, our two primary schools organised or participated in exchange activities in Shanghai, Dongguan, Guangzhou and Shandong, for expanding students' learning perspectives.

Social Services

Pak U Neighbourhood Elderly Centre and Community Care Centre for the Elderly under our Social Services Division are dedicated to providing diversified services for the elderly and their carers in Hung Shui Kiu. Throughout the year, they served over 30,000 visits in total.

This year, we focused on providing diverse services for the elderly and their carers, including the implementation of a two-year “Jockey Club Community eHealth Care Project” to enhance members' awareness of physical health. We also provided preliminary cognitive assessments, consultations, service referrals, and set up street stations to promote Dementia-Friendly Community. We maintained cooperative relationships with representatives from nearby villages to strengthen rural outreach. Additionally, we expanded and offered a variety of innovative activities and programs for the young elderly, and maintained external cooperation to expand resources and provide diverse services. The units also sustained cooperation to enhance the awareness of self-health management and preventive actions among elderly and their carers, to maintain physical, mental, and spiritual health.

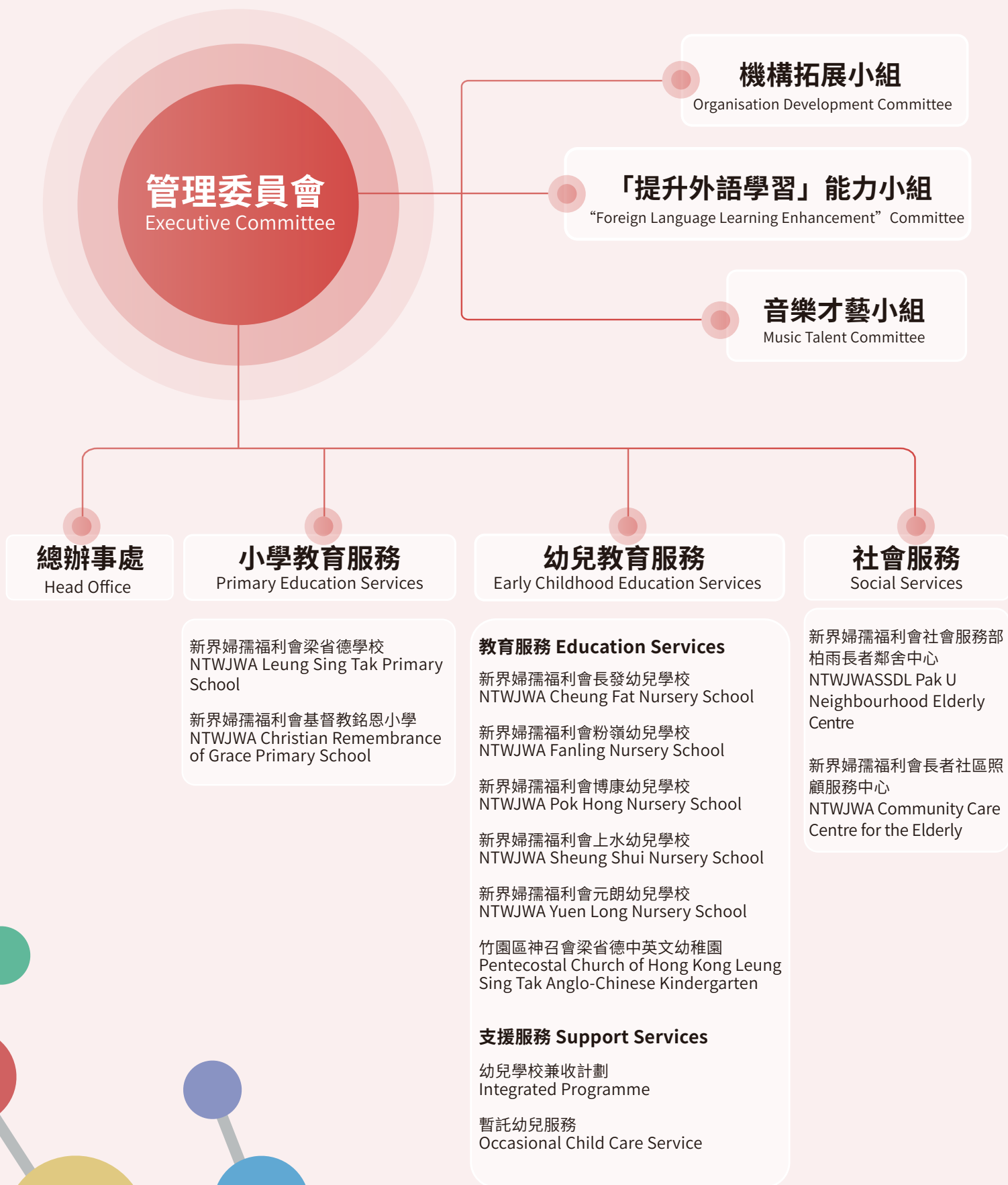
Our Future

幼兒教育服務簡介

Overview of Early Childhood Education Services

新界婦孺福利會一直秉承「以家為本、省德立人」的辦學宗旨，盡心竭力與時並進。幼兒教育服務屬下共有五間幼兒學校（長發幼兒學校、粉嶺幼兒學校、博康幼兒學校、上水幼兒學校、元朗幼兒學校）及一間幼稚園（梁省德中英文幼稚園），每年為全港超過 600 名二至六歲兒童及其家庭提供幼兒教育及家長教育服務。

The New Territories Women & Juveniles Welfare Association has always upheld the motto “Rooted in Family, Built on Virtue”. It strives to do the best and keeps pace with the times. Through our five nursery schools (Cheung Fat Nursery School, Fanling Nursery School, Pok Hong Nursery School, Sheung Shui Nursery School, Yuen Long Nursery School) and one kindergarten (Leung Sing Tak Anglo-Chinese Kindergarten), we serve more than 600 children aged two to six and provide workshops and seminars to their parents.

聯校活動

聯校畢業典禮暨兒童匯演

本會屬下五間幼兒學校於 2023 年 6 月 19 日假葵青劇院舉行聯校畢業典禮暨兒童匯演，主題：「三代樂融融」，當日邀得教育局首席教育主任梁詠珊女士擔任主禮，內容包括幼兒獻唱、授憑儀式、播放幼兒成長片段、幼兒匯演等環節，其中兒童匯演部份更由 133 位畢業生和 134 位家長及祖輩三代合力演出，過程中孩子有機會認識不同年代的衣飾、遊戲及活動景點等，為三代留下美好的回憶。

Joint School Activities

Joint-school Graduation Ceremony cum Children's Performance

Our Association hosted a Joint-school Graduation Ceremony cum Children's Performance with the theme “Three Generations of Blissful Harmony” on 19 June 2023 at the Kwai Tsing Theatre. Ms. LEUNG Wing Shan Magnolia, Principal Education Officer (Kindergarten Education) of the Education Bureau, was our guest of honour. The ceremony included singing the school anthem and the graduation song by the graduates from five schools, certificate presentation and childhood video. There was also a group performance done by 133 graduates together with 134 parents and grandparents. During the process, children learned about different costumes, games and sceneries from different eras. The joint-school graduation ceremony left a wonderful memory for the three generations.

Joint-school Teachers Development Day

On 12 August 2023, we invited Plan International Hong Kong to hold a “Child Safeguarding” workshop at Chi Hong Primary School. The workshop introduced the “Child Safeguarding Policy”, teachers' code of conduct, the mechanism for intervention for students affected by child maltreatment, the Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse Bill, teachers' legal liability and the application and importance of risk assessments.

On 3 October 2023, teachers from our early childhood services attended the “Optimisation of Child Assessment for Quality Learning and Teaching: Diversified Modes and Strategies” workshop at Chi Hong Primary School, with Dr. CHEUNG Sum Kwing Sam, Assistant Professor at the Education University of Hong Kong as the speaker. Dr. CHEUNG shared on creating classroom environments, the relationship between teacher-child interaction and child assessment, and various types of play activities to assess children's learning and development. Teachers learnt how to use “play” to assess children's performance from multiple perspectives, thereby improving their teaching effectiveness and optimising our schools' observation and assessment content.

International Conference and Exchange Program

Our services have always placed great importance on the professional development of its management and teachers. We regularly send our staff abroad for professional exchanges to broaden their educational perspectives. Through these exchanges, the latest educational information is also shared with colleagues, benefiting the children.

學校本年度以「中華文化」為發展重點，加強幼兒的國民身份認同，同時向家長及社區推廣中華文化博大精深和妙趣之處。
This year, our school focuses on promoting “Chinese Culture”. We aim to strengthen children's sense of national identity while promoting the profundity and fascinating aspects of Chinese culture to parents and the community.

教師培訓

學校邀請了綠腳丫有限公司的創辦人柯佳列先生進行兩次教師培訓，包括：「如何利用繪本推動中華文化教育」及「結合主題教學的中華文化活動」。在培訓中，老師認識了揀選中華文化繪本的原則、演繹繪本的技巧和進行與繪本內容相關的體驗活動，如：製作石獅、扎染、拓印等，從而提升老師帶領中華文化活動的知識和技巧。

Teacher Training

Our school invited Mr. Kenny OR, the founder of Little Green Feet Limited, to conduct two teacher training sessions on Chinese cultural education. The sessions covered “How to Utilise Picture Books to Promote Chinese Cultural Education” and “Chinese Cultural Activities Integrated with Thematic Teaching”. During the training, our teachers learned about the principles of selecting appropriate Chinese cultural picture books, techniques for effectively interpreting the books, and how to organise related hands-on experiential activities, such as making stone lions, tie-dyeing, and stone rubbing. This enhanced the teachers' knowledge and capabilities in leading Chinese cultural activities for our students.

Children's Learning

Our school employs thematic picture books, traditional Chinese festivals or events like the “24 Solar Terms cum Birthday Celebrations” to enrich children's understanding of the significance of Chinese culture and traditional customs. For instance, during the “Heavy Snow” and “Winter Solstice” solar term birthday celebrations in December 2023, our teachers led the children in winter wonderland exploration activities, snowball fights, and creating plum blossom paintings. These activities provided insights of plants and natural scenery changes in the winter. Additionally, the children were guided to make tri-colour glutinous rice balls which conveyed the meaning of “family reunion” during the “Winter Solstice”.

Home-School Partnership

Our school showcased the children's learning achievements in Chinese culture through diverse presentation formats and organised parent-child celebration activities during different festivals. For instance, the school held a “Welcoming and Celebrating the Year of the Dragon cum Chinese Culture” learning exhibition. Under the theme of “Chinese Culture Month”, various thematic studies were conducted. K1 class even carried out a special study on pandas. On the event day, they performed “Kung Fu Panda” for the parents, displayed activity photos and related artwork on the theme. The parents and children also enjoyed making “panda rice balls” together.

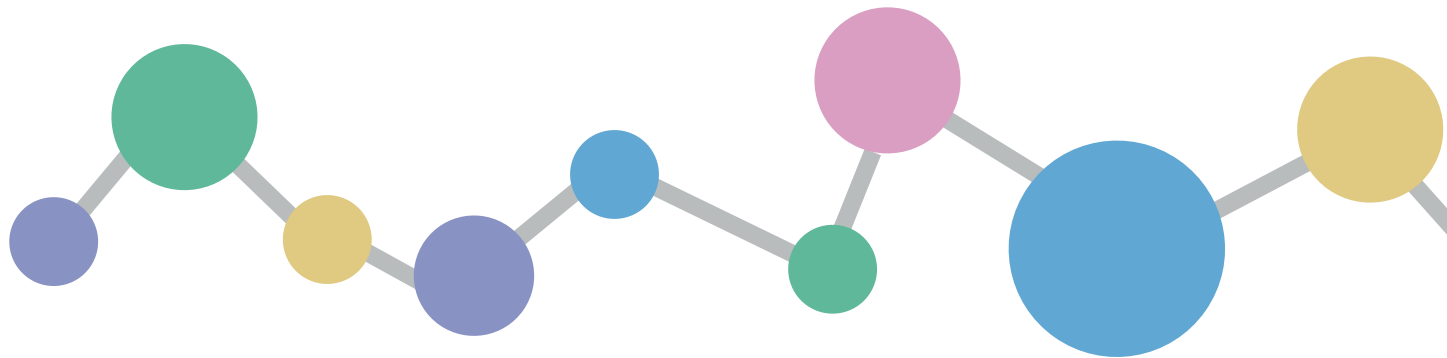

“Promoting Chinese culture, arts and virtues”

本年度以「提升幼兒對中華文化藝術及中華美德的認識，傳揚中華文化」為發展重點，並推動不同的持份者參與，讓幼兒有更大的學習效能。

This year, our school's development focuses on “enhancing young children's understanding of Chinese cultural arts and Chinese virtues, and promoting Chinese culture”. Various stakeholders are involved to enhance the learning effectiveness of young children.

教師培訓

本校聘請專業的導師到校舉行全校教師培訓的活動，包括：麵粉公仔、剪紙、扎染、水墨畫、書法及彩虹書法。教師把學習到的技巧用於教學之中，並在美藝活動中教導幼兒運用，創作不同的藝術作品，教師除透過培訓加強對中華藝術的認識外，亦能透過自身的提升協助推動中華文化。



幼兒學習

學校於開學前整理了音樂及視覺藝術大綱，把中樂及富中華藝術特色的視覺藝術創作有系統地於不同主題內進行。幼兒透過不同的音樂範疇，如音樂欣賞、樂器、舞蹈等來認識中樂的特色。此外，學校亦邀請專家到校為幼兒進行「水墨畫」、「扎染」、「麵粉公仔」及「剪紙」工作坊，配合學校的視覺藝術課程大綱。幼兒除加深對中華藝術的認識外，更融入自己的創意，把中華藝術的獨特之處呈現出來。

Teacher Training

Our school hired professional instructors to conduct school-wide teacher training activities, including dough figurines, paper cutting, tie-dyeing, Chinese ink painting and calligraphy, and rainbow calligraphy. The teachers applied the skills they learned into their teaching and guided children to create various art pieces. Through these training sessions, our teachers not only strengthened their understanding of Chinese arts, but also helped promote Chinese culture through their own improvement.



Children's Learning

The school compiled the music and visual arts curriculum before the start of the school year, systematically incorporating Chinese music and visual arts with Chinese cultural characteristics into different themes. Students learn about the characteristics of Chinese music through different aspects such as music appreciation, musical instruments and dance. Additionally, the school invited experts to conduct workshops in line with the school's visual arts curriculum. This not only deepens children's understanding of Chinese arts, but also allows them to integrate their creativity and showcase the unique aspects of Chinese arts.

另外，本校於 2024 年 1 月開展「中華文化月」的研習中，幼兒對「舞獅」、「川劇變面」、「皮影戲」及「雜耍」甚感興趣，因此學校邀請了專業團隊到校為幼兒進行體驗活動，讓幼兒把體驗到的用於學習。例如：於模擬區進行街頭雜耍表演、探索光與影、製作皮影戲偶及進行舞獅採青演出等。

Furthermore, our school launched the “Chinese Culture Month” in January 2024. During the learning process, young children showed great interest in the “lion dance”, “Sichuan opera face-changing”, “shadow puppetry” and “juggling”. Therefore, the school invited professional teams to conduct experiential activities for the children, allowing them to apply what they experienced in their learning. For example, they performed street juggling, explored light and shadow, made shadow puppets, and performed lion dances in the dramatic corners.

而學校為培養幼兒「仁」「禮」「孝」的中華美德，本年度把這三個美德融入主題教學活動。例如：

In order to cultivate the Chinese virtues of “benevolence”, “propriety”, and “filial piety” in young children, the school integrated these three virtues into thematic teaching activities this year. For example:

「仁」- 在「動物」主題中，幼兒透過親身照顧小動物學習關愛及善待動物的舉動，亦會設計動物保養區，以免動物受到傷害。

Benevolence - Under the “Animals” theme, children learned to care for and treat animals kindly by personally taking care of them. They also designed an animal care area to prevent animals from being harmed.

「禮」- 在「食物」主題中，幼兒透過模擬區及親身上茶樓學習飲食及飲茶禮儀。

「孝」- 在「家庭」主題中，幼兒透過模擬母親懷孕體驗媽媽的辛勞，學會幫助做家務，自己的事自己做，從而減低父母的工作，學習感恩及孝順。

學校按主題設計了不同的「品德任務小冊子」，讓幼兒把課堂所學有關「仁」「禮」「孝」的品德延伸至家中，幼兒均能完成小冊子的任務，而家長亦有不同的回饋，如：小朋友進食時會安坐、安靜進食、亦會協助收拾碗碟、提示家長要用環保袋、減少用膠袋等，可見幼兒可以把學習延至日常。

另外，在 2024 年 3 月 16 日學校舉行了「親子中華文化日」，除將幼兒富中華藝術特色的視覺藝術作品呈現外，更能讓家長及幼兒體驗中華童玩、食品及不同的民族服飾。

Home-School Partnership

The school has designed different “Moral Task Booklets” based on the themes of “benevolence”, “propriety” and “filial piety”, allowing children to extend what they have learned from the classroom to their daily lives. Children completed the tasks in the booklets and the parents provided positive feedback, such as children eating calmly and quietly during meals, helping to clean up dishes, and reminding their parents to use eco-friendly bags instead of plastic bags.

Furthermore, on 16 March 2024, the school held a “Parent-Child Chinese Culture Day”. Besides showcasing children's visual art works with Chinese cultural characteristics, it also allowed parents and children to experience traditional Chinese toys, food, and different ethnic costumes together.

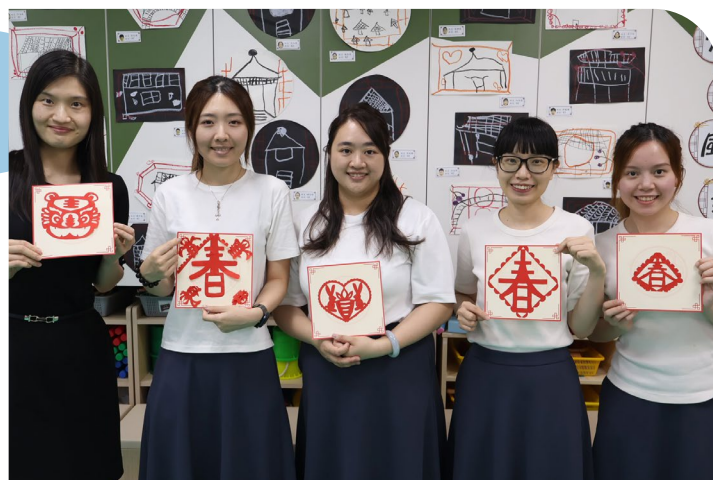

Teacher Training

Our school invited art instructors to provide training in Chinese ink painting, paper cutting, and pottery to all teachers, enabling them to acquire relevant skills and effective teaching methods. Additionally, we utilised the “Professional Capacity Enhancement Grant” to offer all teaching staff the “Carl Orff Autumn and Winter K1 to K3 Music Game Course (New Cantonese Version)”, enhancing teachers' skills in leading music activities. Children's Learning

Our school provided a variety of activities for children to learn about traditional Chinese art and culture. By visiting the “Hong Kong Toy Story” exhibition at the Hong Kong Heritage Museum, the Cantonese Opera Heritage Hall, and Lai Chi Kok Park, children explored and appreciated traditional Chinese games, cuisine and architecture. We also invited professional teams to perform Sichuan Opera face-changing for our children, allowing them to learn about the history and different mask designs of face-changing, and to appreciate the unique essence of Chinese Sichuan Opera.

Furthermore, our school incorporated Chinese culture and art, such as Chinese ink painting, blue-and-white porcelain, clay modeling, paper cutting, and Chinese dance, into our monthly thematic activities. These activities enhanced children's understanding and appreciation of Chinese art, allowing them to experience the national artistic and cultural heritage, thereby fostering a sense of national identity.

Home-School Partnership

Our school organised various activities for parents and children to experience traditional Chinese art and culture together. Parent-child celebrations were held during different festivals, including “Harmony and Reunion in Mid-Autumn” and “Welcoming the Dragon Year in Spring”, introducing the customs and meanings behind traditional festivals. Parents and children enjoyed shadow play and the making of dragon's beard candy, deepening their understanding of traditional Chinese culture and customs.

Furthermore, in line with the Lion Dance theme, our school invited parents who are lion dance experts to perform the lion dance, answer children's questions, and teach the basic steps of lion dance, initiating a deeper exploration of the theme among children.

Professional Collaboration

Our school participated in the Jockey Club “CoolPlay” Project Phase 2. There were four professional training sessions and four on-site professional guidance sessions, including lesson planning, lesson observation and lesson evaluation. Teachers learned how to help children learn through exploration as well as understand the importance of the teacher's role and the learning environmental setup. The program co-organisers also held three parent-child science exploration workshops to enrich their learning experience.

Teacher Training

Our school participated in the Quality Education Fund's “Enhanced My Pledge to Act Funding Program” and conducted a series of teacher training and on-site professional guidance services. Teachers learned how to design various learning experiences for children based on traditional arts such as yangge dance, water sleeve dance, fan painting, sugar painting, Dragon Boat Festival five-color bracelet, and juggling. Teachers were able to deepen their understanding of the essence of traditional Chinese arts, and then applied it in their teaching to enhance children's knowledge of Chinese art.

We also utilised the “Professional Capacity Enhancement Grant” to provide body movement training for all our teachers, enhancing their skills in leading music and movement activities. During the training, teachers learned to use different parts of their bodies to explore the space, angles and speed of objects, completed various tasks through group collaboration, and recognised the possibilities of the body in a pleasant atmosphere. Later, the school held a parent-child movement class, allowing parents to experience the joy of physical activity as well as strengthen the relationship with their children.

Our school provided a variety of activities for young children to experience the culture and history of ancient and modern China, such as Chinese ink painting, classical poetry, Chinese dance, folktales and traditional Chinese toys. This year, the school also designed activities in line with the 24 solar terms, allowing children to experience different customs. For example, children planted crops during "Corn Rain"; reaped a bountiful harvest during "Autumnal Equinox"; and practiced calligraphy, painting, and the egg-balancing game during "Spring commences". During "Insects waken", they discovered insects and made insect repellent herbal sachets as gifts to their family members and the elderly, expressing "gratitude" and "care" to others and demonstrating the virtues of "benevolence" and "propriety".

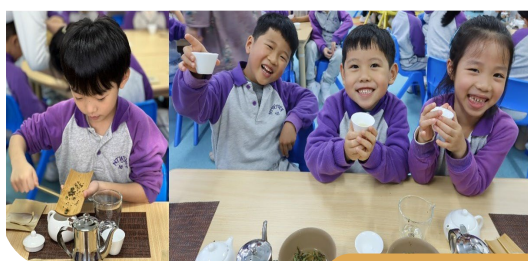

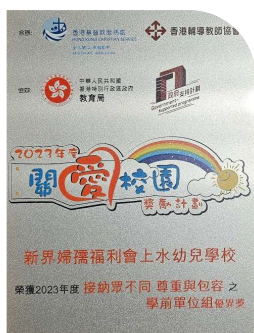

學校本年度以「在自主探索遊戲中促進幼兒的解難能力」為發展重點，透過有系統的綜合課程設計，將自由遊戲融入課程，讓幼兒從遊戲中學習，提升好奇心、探索精神及自主學習的態度。

This year, our school focuses on promoting children's problem-solving skills through self-directed exploration play. Through systematic and integrated curriculum design, free play is incorporated into the curriculum to enhance children's curiosity, spirit of exploration and self-directed learning attitude.

學校重視課程發展的穩健性和教師的專業發展。本學年學校除參與賽馬會童亮計劃第二階段「環評同行專業啟導」培訓計劃，學習運用國際認可工具《幼兒學習環境評量表》，為幼兒提供及持續檢討適切和豐富的教學環境；並分別參與教育局及香港幼稚園教育專業交流協會舉辦的專業海外學術交流，例如校長跟隨教育局到訪澳洲，了解當地教育體制及環境，五位教師跟隨香港幼稚園教育專業交流協會分別到訪上海、杭州及廣州進行安吉遊戲交流活動，觀摩內地進行自由遊戲教學的特點。學術交流後，校長帶領老師分享、反思及討論，運用可行及適切的策略，發展成為本校特色。

Teacher Training

Our school attaches great importance to the robustness of curriculum development and the professional development of teachers. This school year, we participated in the KeySteps@JC (Phase Two) “Environmental Assessment Peer Mentorship” training program. We learned to use the internationally recognised “Early Childhood Environment Rating Scale” to provide and continuously review appropriate and enriching teaching environments for our children. The school also participated in professional overseas exchange programs organised by the Education Bureau and the Hong Kong Kindergarten Education Professional Exchange Association. Our principal visited Australia with the Education Bureau to learn about the local education system and environment, while five teachers visited Shanghai, Hangzhou and Guangzhou with the Hong Kong Kindergarten Education Professional Exchange Association to observe the characteristics of Anji Play in Mainland China. After the academic exchanges, our principal led the teachers to share, reflect and discuss their experiences and develop feasible and appropriate strategies into our school features.

Home-School Partnership

Schools and parents firmly believe in the importance of play in the lives, learning, and development of young children. Children can develop their maximum potential through play. In response to "International Play Day" on 11 June each year, the Parent-Teacher Association collaborated with the "Playright Children's Play Association" to organise play activities. This allows children to engage in self-directed play and exploration, while parents volunteer to assist the school in implementing free play by observing and recording the children's play activities. The event helps parents understand children's thinking, focus, observation, and organisation skills. When children of different ages come together, they can experience various spontaneous learning opportunities, including on-the-spot adjustment, cooperation, patience, and even creative problem-solving. The event has received participation and support from parents, working together to provide high-quality early childhood education services.

International Exchange

This school year, some professionals and scholars visited our "Happy Friday". Among the visitors were members of the Hong Kong Early Childhood Education Professional Exchange Association's Anji Play Learning Circle, Professor Kathy SYLVA from the University of Oxford's Department of Education (Educational Psychology), and Dr. Maria LEE, President of the Pacific Early Childhood Education Research Association (Hong Kong). They visited our "Happy Friday" sessions and gave positive feedback. They believed that the school had excelled in creating an environment and preparing materials that foster children's autonomous exploration and learning. 本年度學校致力於推廣探究學習，以培養幼兒的探究精神。為此，本校在校園內增設 STEM 建構牆、磁石牆及大型積木建構區等，讓幼兒透過自由遊戲和自主探索，如在搭建和重組的過程中學習操弄工具、提出問題和驗證，激發創意和想像力，培養幼兒的探索精神和創造力。同時，學校又創設豐富多元的感官刺激學習環境，鼓勵幼兒透過視覺、聽覺、嗅覺和觸覺來探索感官桌內不同質感、形狀、顏色和氣味的大自然素材，讓幼兒從感官體驗中發展出對事物的觀察力、敏感度和感知能力。

Teacher Training

Our teachers participated in the Hong Kong Jockey Club CoolPlay project, a joint initiative of Yew Chung College of Early Childhood Education and Hong Kong Christian Service. The program aims to give teachers inspiration to incorporate exploratory learning into the current curriculum so as to stimulate children's interest and talent in STEAM exploration. It is hoped to cultivate an innovative thinking from a young age, enabling them to excel in their respective fields in the future.

Moreover, all our teachers attended a training workshop on Orff Music Pedagogy. Activities such as rhythmic movements, singing, dancing, ensemble playing and improvising have broadened teachers' understanding of music and enhanced their capacity to plan and execute diverse music activities. Our goal is to spark children's love and interest in music, increase their imagination and creativity, and build children's motivation for learning through quality music education.

Children's Learning

This year, our school aimed to promote our children's exploring learning skills. To attain this, the school has introduced a STEM Wall, a magnetic wall and a giant block area where children were allowed to play and explore independently. Children's exploration spirit and creativity were stimulated as they learnt to manipulate tools, ask questions and verify during the building and reassembling process. The school has also created a rich and diverse sensory-stimulating "sensory table" for children to explore different natural materials so as to develop their sensitivity as well as their observation and perception skills.

此外，教師亦為幼兒提供多元化的探索和操作機會，鼓勵幼兒從「做」中學習，如動手探索發射器的組成、觀察和探索磁力車相吸和相斥的現象、探索紙杯疊高的方法等，讓幼兒透過實際的參與，自主探索、假設、發現、創作，獲得第一手的經驗，使幼兒在遊戲中學習，在體驗中成長，在探索中展現創意，啟發他們的思考和解難能力，並培養自主學習的探究精神。

Our teachers also provided students with diverse exploration and hand-on opportunities such as how launchers were made, how magnetic car attract and repel, and how to stack paper cups, encouraging them to learn by doing. Children acquired first-hand experience through actual participation, autonomous exploration, hypothesis, discovery and creation. Through play and actual experiences, children's creativity, thinking, problem-solving and exploration spirit were inspired and nurtured.

We hope to cultivate students' diverse interests and develop their different potentials through these activities.

We organised parent-teacher meetings, workshops and family days in various formats such as “How to Cultivate Children's Reading Habits Seminar”, “Parent-Child Massage Workshop”, “Open Day”, “Christmas Celebration”, “Chinese New Year Market”, “Sports Day”, to encourage parents and children to engage in school life together. We also invited parents to school for “lesson observation”, allowing them to have a better understanding of their children's learning and work together for their children's growth.

教材玩具借用

兼收服務在各幼兒學校推動教材玩具借用計劃，配合家居訓練，向家長借出玩具、教具及參考書，本年度借出的資源數量達 620 人次。

教師培訓

本會一直鼓勵同工進修，提升專業知識與技巧，優化服務質素，年內進行不同培訓。

教師發展日

2024 年 3 月 28 日全體兼收老師參與英國 NFPS 認可培訓中心舉辦「幼兒服務之人本脫身法及約束法認證課程」；讓老師了解使用約束或隔離的方法處理特殊幼兒嚴重情緒行為問題，包括根據普通法的案例，在緊急情況下保障幼兒及其他人士安全的「合理方法」，讓老師們認識處理幼兒挑戰性行為的相關法律考慮，學習可行及安全的方法及技巧保障幼兒及自身的安全。

持續進修

過去一年，三位同工分別進修專業碩士、學士及校長課程。其他同工亦參加了多個不同類型的進修學習及專題講座，如：桌遊治療、感覺統合、LEGO 積木遊戲治療等，提昇專業知識。

觀課活動

過去一年安排兼收老師進行了八節互相觀課，並在小組會議中作分享及討論，藉此加強老師們對教學及輔導技巧的掌握。

Teaching Materials and Toys Borrowing Scheme

The service promotes the Teaching Materials and Toys Borrowing Scheme in all our nursery schools. We lent toys, teaching aids and reference books to parents for their home-based training. Resources were lent out 620 times during the year.

Teacher Training

Our Association has always encouraged staff to pursue further studies to enhance their professional knowledge and skills, thereby improving service quality. Different trainings have been conducted throughout the year.

Teacher Development Day

On 28 March 2024, all IP teachers participated in the “Certificate in Positive Handling System® for Child Service with NFPS Breakaway & Restraint Techniques”. This course helped teachers understand the use of restraint or seclusion to deal with serious emotional behavioural problems of SEN students, including what constitutes a “reasonable method” to protect the safety of children and others in emergencies based on the cases of the common law. Our teachers learned about the legal considerations in dealing with challenging behaviour of children and acquired practical and safe methods and techniques to safeguard children and themselves.

Continuing Education

In the past year, three IP teachers have studied professional master's, bachelor's and principal courses respectively. Others also participated in different types of further studies and seminars such as board game therapy, sensory integration, LEGO®-Based Therapy, to enhance their professional knowledge.

Lesson Observation

In the past year, we conducted eight sessions of lesson observations and arranged IP teachers to share and discuss with each other in group meetings afterwards. Through these interactions, we enhance our teachers' mastery of teaching and student support skills.

服務目標

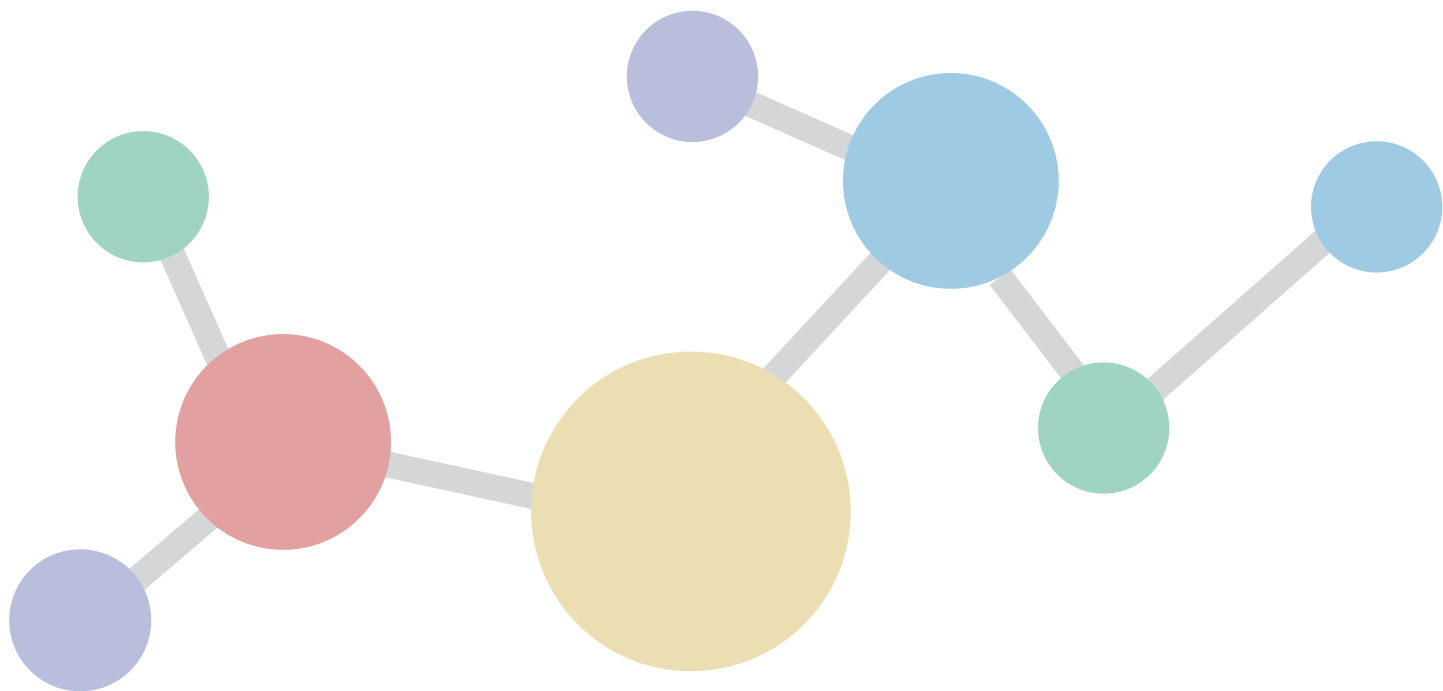

本年度共有 24 班，學生人數 537 人，教師 48 名，社工兩名，非教學人員 24 名。92% 教師持學士學位，當中 38% 具碩士學位，2% 具博士學位，65% 已接受特殊教育培訓。

To Promote STEAM Education

An appropriate and beneficial STEAM learning environment has been created at school. E-Learning supporting measures have been optimised. In addition, more learning space and equipments are provided to support all-round STEAM learning. The E-Learning Development Team assisted the school in planning and implementing e-learning in various subjects.

Class Structure and Teacher Credentials

This year, there are 24 classes with 537 students, 48 teachers, two social workers and 24 non-teaching staff. 92% of our teaching staff are bachelor's degree holders while 38% have master's degrees. 2% are doctorate degree holders and 65% have received special education training.

學習支援

本年度在兩個小息開設「好學室」以照顧學習能力較弱的學生，並於課後開辦功課輔導班支援成績稍遜的學生；此外，本校安排特殊教育需要教學助理協助有學習需要的學生在課堂中學習。針對學生不同需要，學校參與不同計劃，如「全校參與分層支援有自閉症的學生」、「賽馬會喜伴同行計劃」、「醫教社同心協作計劃」等。

本校聘請了四位課室助理，以加強對小一學生的照顧，做好「幼小銜接」的工作。另外，在周六推出「足動潛能」足球班、「喜動籃兒」籃球班及「音樂治療」小組，透過體藝協助及支援有特殊教育需要的學生。

Learning and Teaching

Our school values the diverse potential of students and makes good use of learning time to cultivate students' basic knowledge in varied academic areas. The afternoon class time has been optimised by incorporating “Integrated Humanities Classes”, “Enrichment and Extension Classes” as well as “Interdisciplinary Classes”. This allows students to apply the knowledge they learnt, combining reading, scientific exploration activities and hands-on activities to naturally connect the knowledge with their daily lives. Students can also step out of the classrooms to participate in different community visits, adventure activities and exchange programs, broadening their horizons and enriching themselves.

Learning Support

“Learning Rooms” have been set up during two recesses to take care of students with learning difficulties. After-school tutorial classes are also available to support students with academic challenges. The school has also arranged teaching assistants to assist students with special educational needs. To cater for the diverse needs of the students, the school has participated in various programs such as “Whole School Approach to Providing Tiered Support for Students with ASD”, “Jockey Club Autism Support Network” and “Student Mental Health Support Scheme”.

To ensure smooth transition between kindergarten and primary school, the school arranged four classroom assistants to take care P.1 students. Furthermore, “Football Potential”, “Happy Basketball” and “Music Therapy” groups are held on Saturdays to assist and support students with special educational needs through sports and arts.

另外，本年度亦於成館增設了「自然角」，我們飼養了爬行動物及甲蟲，同學能近距離與牠們接觸。

最後，本年圖書館將進行大型翻新工程，全新的圖書館於8月中旬面世。新圖書館不單能提升館內藏書量，同時亦可提升學生閱讀空間。圖書館設計新穎，不單可作為圖書館進行圖書課教學，亦可搖身一變成為故事演繹舞台。

School-based Teacher Training

The school provides guidance to our teachers to attend training courses based on their professional disciplines every school year. Professional lectures and workshops are provided for teachers in response to the school's major concerns. In this school year, teachers received training in the preparation of External School Review and the skills of class observations, which helped middle management in the school have a better understanding of the External School Review.

Campus Improvement

In order to create a better English reading environment, an “English Reading Tree Room” has been established in the Art Gallery. A comfortable, quiet and relaxing place is provided for students to participate in English reading activities during recesses.

A “Nature Corner” has also been set up at the Hall of Success. Students can have a chance to meet up close with the reptiles and the beetles at recess time.

The school library has carried out renovation works and the new library has been launched in mid-August. The new library will not only increase the library collection of books but also enhance the reading space for students. With the novel design, it can be a classroom for library lessons or a stage for storytelling after transformation.

Life-wide Learning Activities and Exchanges

There were three exchange programs this year, including the “An Exploration into the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Cities - Planning and Technology Development in Dongguan” in November, the “Mainland Exchange Program for Junior Secondary and Upper Primary Students (History and Culture Series in Shanghai)” in March, the “Sister School Scheme with Junwei Primary School, Huadu District, Guangzhou”.

External Competitions

The school is committed to supporting the development of sports and we reaped great harvests in sports competitions this year. The Badminton Team won the Boys' Team Championship in the “Tai Po District Inter-School Badminton Competition 2023-2024”. In the Boy's Individual Event, which each school could only send two players to participate, won the Championship and the First Runner-up awards. The Table Tennis Team performed even better, sweeping the awards in the “Tai Po District Inter-School Table Tennis Team Competition 2023-2024”, and winning both the Boys' and Girls' Team Championships. As for the Dodgeball Team, the Boys' Team won the 3rd runner-up in the “Hong Kong Inter-School Dodgeball (Single-ball Style) Championships 2024 (New Territories East)”, while the Girls' Team went one step further, winning the Championship in the same competition. After advancing to the Hong Kong-wide competition, the Girls' Team won the third place in the Primary School Girls' Category of “Hong Kong Inter-School Dodgeball (Single-ball Style) Elite Championships 2024”.

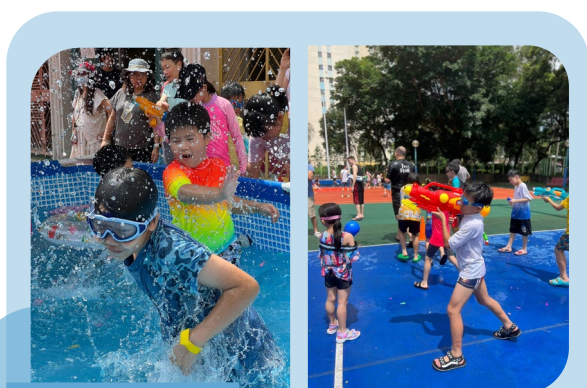

社會服務概覽

Overview of Social Services

秉承本會「以家為本、省德立人」理念，社會服務部致力為區內的長者及其家庭提供適切及到位的服務。社會服務轄下共有兩個服務單位，分別為柏雨長者鄰舍中心及長者社區照顧服務中心。透過社區支援服務包括到戶和中心為本服務，為洪水橋內體弱、體健長者及其照顧者提供多元化的身、心、社、靈活動，協助服務使用者渡過有意義及豐盛的晚年生活。

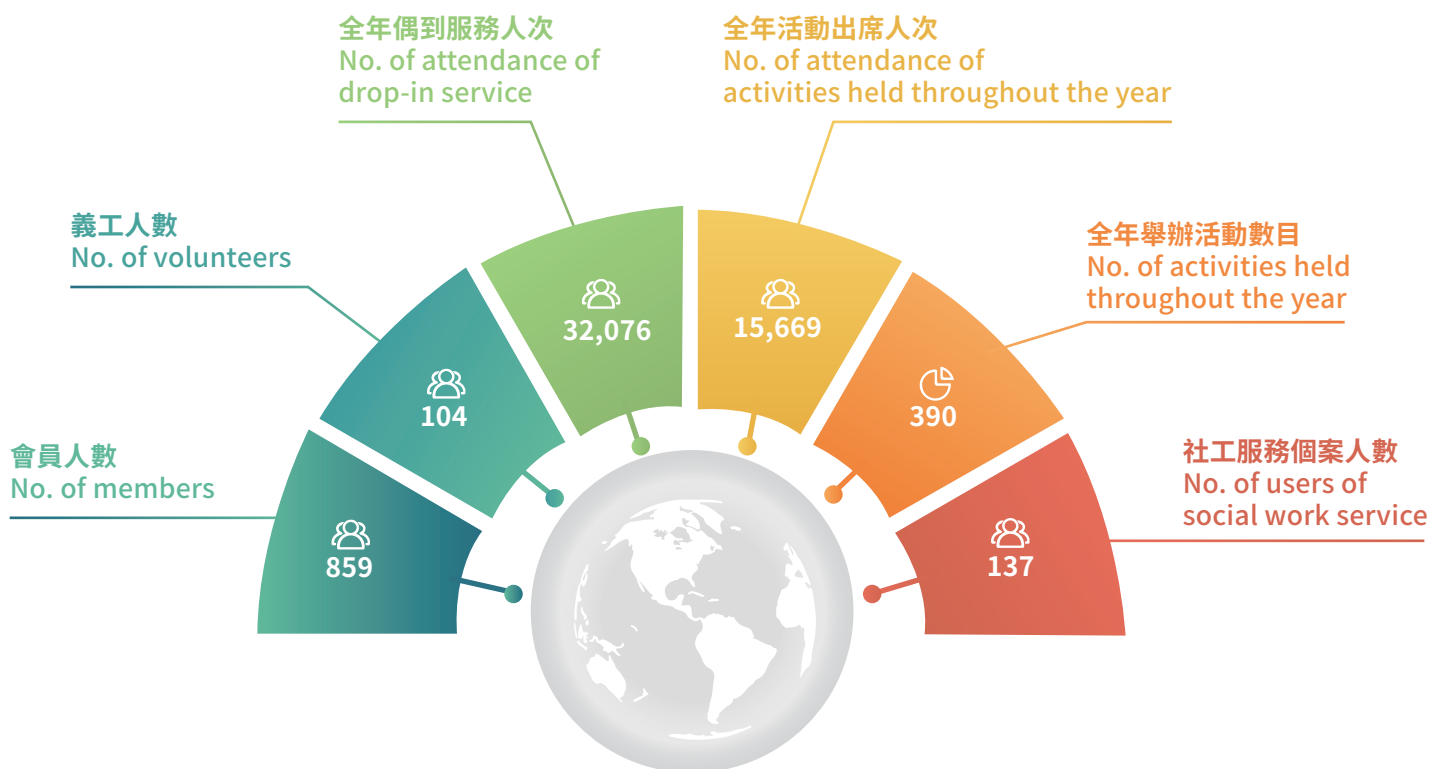
人口老化對於全球經濟、社會資源、醫療、長期護理及福利等等都帶來重大的挑戰。面對本港安老服務的需求日益增加及複雜多變的服務使用者需要，社會服務部會致力提升中心服務的質素及積極與不同團體合作，包括：非政府機構、地區組織、長者學苑、區內中小學校、大專院校及政府部門等。期望透過多元資源合作提供更多樣及優質的服務予服務使用者。

In line with our organisation's mission, “Rooted in Family, Built on Virtue”, the Social Service Division is committed to providing appropriate and in-depth services to the elderly and their families in need. There are two service units under the Social Service Division, namely Pak U Neighbourhood Elderly Centre and Community Care Centre for the Elderly. Through community support services, including home-based and centre-based services, we provide a variety of physical, psycho, social and spiritual activities for both the frail and healthy elderly and their carers in Hung Shui Kiu. We aim to assist our service users live a meaningful and fulfilling later lives through different activities.

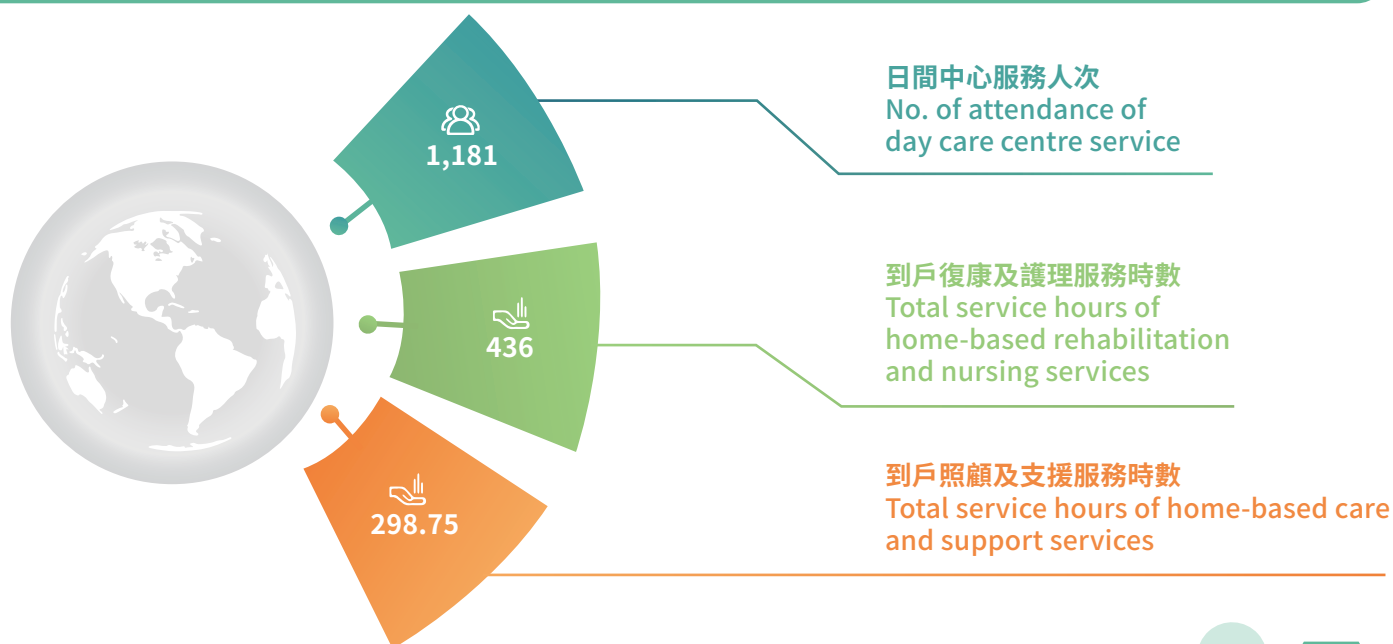
The aging population poses significant challenges to the global economy, social resources, healthcare, long-term care, and welfare. In view of the increasing demand for elderly services in Hong Kong and the complex and changing needs of service users, the Social Service Division will strive to enhance the quality of the services and actively collaborate with different groups, including non-governmental organisations, district organisations, Elder Academy, primary and secondary schools, tertiary institutions, and government departments in the district. We aim to provide more diversified and high-quality services to our service users through diversified resource collaboration.

服務重點

中心繼續秉承「以家為本、省德立人」的理念提供適切服務予有需要人士。本年度中心專注為長者及護老者提供多元化的服務，包括：提升會員對身體健康的關注；強化認知友善推廣；加強鄉郊宣傳，發展鄉郊服務；開拓青老群體，為青老提供多元化創新活動；保持對外合作，拓展資源提供多元化服務。

服務團隊

中心服務團隊由社工、福利工作人員、活動幹事、助理文員及庶務員組成。另外，社會福利署於 2023 年 10 月通過撥款增聘一名社會工作助理，人手增加及專業的團隊能讓中心的服務可向更多元化及更高質素方面發展。同時，中心亦會定期舉辦內部培訓及鼓勵同事接受外間舉辦的訓練課程，以提升自己的知識與技能水平，使服務更專業化及跟上時代的需求。因應團隊內有職員的新舊交替，為了加強合作關係與溝通，中心舉行團隊建立工作坊，透過各類活動，讓團隊人員互相了解，以便在工作上能夠通力合作，互助互信。

服務概要

提升會員對身體健康的關注

香港賽馬會慈善信託基金撥款 780,000 元予中心推行為期兩年的「賽馬會 e 健樂電子健康管理計劃」，透過創新的服務模式，提升長者自我健康管理的能力，促進長者保健安康。中心於 2023 年 7 月 1 日開始推行本計劃，並招募 55 歲或以上有意培養健康生活方式的人士參與。e 健樂參加者可以透過智能卡在中心使用電子健康站（量血壓、度高、磅重、體重成份分析儀），更加了解自身健康情況。計劃另一重點在於透過雲端技術，實時傳送健康數據至研究團隊作監察和跟進，使參加者的健康狀況可以得到適時的跟進。計劃除了健康指數的監控外，亦會舉行各類健康推廣活動如運動、健康飲食、認知健康、精神健康及社交心理健康，全方位關注長者晚年的生活質素。

Service Mission

Pak U Neighbourhood Elderly Centre continues to adhere to the mission of “Rooted in Family, Built on Virtue” to provide appropriate services to those in need. This year, the centre focuses on providing a wide range of services to the elderly and their carers, including enhancing members' awareness of physical health, strengthening cognitive-friendly promotion, intensifying rural publicity and developing rural services, developing the young old service and offering diversified and innovative activities for the young elderly, maintaining external cooperation to broaden resources for diversified services.

Service Team

Our team is composed of social workers, welfare workers, program workers, clerical assistant, and workman. In addition, the Social Welfare Department allocated additional funding in October 2023 to recruit an additional social work assistant. A well-staffed and professional team will enable the centre to diversify its services and enhance its quality. Moreover, the centre regularly organises internal training and encourages colleagues to participate in external training courses to improve their knowledge and skills, ensuring more professional and up-to-date services. To strengthen cooperation and communication among the team, the centre organises team building workshops, allowing team members to understand each other better and collaborate effectively in their work, fostering mutual trust and support.

Service Overview

Increase Members' Awareness on Physical Health

The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust has allocated \$780,000 to the centre to launch the two-year “Jockey Club Community eHealth Care Project”. It adopts an innovative approach to promote preventive healthcare among the elderly and empower them in health management. The program recruits people aged 55 or above who are interested in living a healthy lifestyle since July 2023. eHealth participants can login to the e-health stations with their smart cards to conduct health measurement (blood pressure, height, weight, body composition analysis) so as to understand their health conditions. The health data are transferred through cloud technology for real-time monitoring and analysis. In addition, the project also

中心本年度共招收 260 位計劃成員、服務 1,552 人次，並舉辦 117 次活動。本計劃更開展了與區內團體的協作活動，例如與元朗地區康健中心合作，合辦「護士與你」活動，由護士與參加者量血壓、紀錄身高體重、腰圍等，又即時為 e 健樂成員或中心會員進行健康諮詢。每季亦會舉行一次半日遊活動，讓參加者參觀元朗地區康健中心，認識地區上的基層醫療資源。

強化認知友善服務

中心本年度的認知障礙症支援服務以預防、及早識別、支援認知障礙症長者及其照顧者作為目標。中心為有需要長者提供初步的認知評估、諮詢及服務轉介，當發現長者出現認知能力下降的跡象時，專責的職員會為他們提供多元化的小組及活動，例如：懷緬治療、音樂治療及桌遊訓練等，訓練及維持他們的認知能力。推廣認知友善社區亦是中心本年度認知障礙症的服務重點之一。除了為洪福邨的物業管理人員進行認知友善培訓外，中心更派出職員及義工在社區擺設街站宣傳認知障礙症的資訊，提高公眾人士對認知障礙症的關注並發掘有需要的人士及護老者。

This year, the centre has recruited 260 participants, total of 1,552 attendance, and held 117 activities. The project also collaborated with local community, such as co-organise the “Nurse and You” activity with Yuen Long District Health Centre. The nurse measured blood pressure, recorded height, weight and waist circumference for the participants, and provided health consultation for the members. Half-day excursion is also arranged every quarter for participants to visit the Yuen Long District Health Centre and learn about the primary medical resources in the district.

Strengthen Dementia-Friendly Services

This year, the centre's dementia services focus on prevention, early identification, and supporting the elderly with dementia and their carers. The centre provides preliminary cognitive assessment, consultation, and service referral to the elderly in need. When the elderly is found to have signs of dementia, our staff will provide them diverse groups and activities, such as reminiscence therapy, music therapy and board game training to train and maintain their cognitive abilities. Promoting dementia-friendly community is also one of the centre's dementia service priorities this year. In addition to conducting dementia-friendly training for the property management staff of Hung Fuk Estate, information booths were setup for delivering information about dementia, raising public awareness and identifying elderly and carers in need.

拓展青老服務

增加服務第三齡人士已是本港長者服務的大趨勢，中心本年以不同手法推廣青老服務，除舉辦專門給予55-59歲人士參加的活動外，亦加強於區內的宣傳。中心與地區上的團體及政府部門合作，以不同手法接觸及發掘有需要的青老，如在洪福邨內各座信箱派發宣傳單張、擺設宣傳街站、於邨內區議員辦事處及仁愛堂過渡性房屋仁愛居張貼活動海報及放置宣傳單張。

另為回應現今青老的學習及發展需要，中心為青老設計專門的活動如「創意咖啡拉花 2D 畫花工作坊」活動、「平安三寶」退休策劃講座以及不同類型的新興活動、社交康樂班組等。這些活動與傳統長者活動相比，更著重培養青老的興趣和發揮他們的能力，使這批即將退休而尚具備活動的群體能善用退休後的時間，建立精彩的人生下半場。

Enhance and Develop Rural Services

The centre maintains a cooperative relationship with representatives from nearby villages. Information sites are established in some villages in order to provide up-to-date information of the centre. As a result, elderly and carers living in villages can easily access information about social welfare and are able to contact the centre when needed. This year, the centre has also made use of street stations, village festivals activities and health check-ups to reach out to more people in the rural area and promote various support services. By enhancing the understanding of elderly in villages about our services, we aim to establish a rural mutual aid network so that service users in the village can receive timely support.

Expand Services for Young Elderly

Responding to the trend to serving the third-age population in Hong Kong, the centre actively promotes services for the young elderly. In addition to organising activities for people aged 55 to 59, the centre intensifies local publicity efforts. The centre cooperates with different stakeholders and government departments to reach out and identify young elderly in need through different ways, such as distributing promotional leaflets in mailboxes within Hung Fuk Estate, setting up street stations, and placing leaflets and posters in District Councillor's Office and Hung Shui Kiu Transitional Housing Project – Yan Oi House.

To address the learning and developmental needs of the young elderly, the centre has designed special activities such as “Creative Coffee Art 2D Painting Workshop”, “Safety Three Treasures” retirement planning talks and various trendy activities, recreational classes and groups. Unlike traditional activities in elderly centres, these activities focus more on cultivating the interests of young elderly and developing their abilities, enabling the young elderly who are about to retire to make good use of their post-retirement time and create a vibrant second half of their lives.

保持對外合作，拓展資源提供多元化服務

在過去一年，中心繼續與區內友好單位保持良好合作關係並舉辦多項特色活動。本中心在 2023 年度成為社企民間高峰會社區培訓計劃 @ 元朗 - 第四屆「青年動力·社區創新」案例比賽的案例機構，共有七隊來自四間元朗區中學的參賽隊伍，透過學習並實踐設計思維，應用設計思維為中心度身訂造創新點子及對中心提出改善及發展建議。於 2024 年 2 至 3 月中心成功引入勝出隊伍的設計思維方案，優化現有服務。計劃除了為中心帶來新服務點子外，學生亦可藉比賽了解非牟利機構運作，締造雙贏及有效促進長幼共融。另外，於 2023 年 11 月中心亦與理工大學護理學院合作，使用「透過電子繪畫和同伴支持」(EPPS) 平台，讓護老者學習繪畫互相交流及紓緩壓力。2024 年度中心會繼續與柏崇長者學苑及和富社區共享長者學苑舉辦活動，同時亦會繼續發掘社區資源，透過不同類型的合作為中心帶來更加多元化及創新的服務。

Maintain External Cooperation and Expand Resources to Provide Diversified Services

In the past year, the centre has continued to maintain good collaborations with friendly units in the district and organised various special activities. In 2023, our centre served as a case organisation for the SE Program @ Yuen Long - 4th "Youth Power Community Innovation" Case Competition held by the Social Enterprise Summit. A total of seven teams from four secondary schools in Yuen Long District participated in the competition. The students applied design thinking to tailor innovative ideas for the centre and made suggestions for improvement and development of the centre. During February to March 2024, the centre successfully introduced the design thinking plan of the winning team to optimise existing services. In addition to bring new service ideas to the centre, the program also allowed students to learn about the operations of non-profit organisations through competitions, creating a win-win situation and effectively promoting harmony across generations. In November 2023, the centre cooperated with the School of Nursing at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University to use the "Electronic Painting and Peer Support" (EPPS) platform, enabling carers to learn painting, communicate with each other and relieve stress. In 2024, the centre continues to organise activities with Pak Shung Elder Academy and Wofoo Community Hub Elder Academy. At the same time, we will continue to explore community resources and bring more diversified and innovative services to the centre through different types of cooperation.

Future Development

The centre carries decades of community relations and service experience in Hung Shui Kiu and will celebrate its 30th anniversary in 2024. At the same time, we are going to face major changes due to the new planning and development in the district. In the coming years, numerous new residential buildings and mass railway transportation projects will be completed, bringing various opportunities to the area. The centre will proactively strengthen its positioning, develop regional networks, and actively expand various resources. For example, this year we received a grant of \$100,000 from the Helena May Hong Kong to implement a project aimed at supporting female carers in need, providing different types of carer training and home support services. The centre will develop steadily, preparing to embrace new opportunities.

本中心為社會福利署「長者社區照顧服務券計劃」的認可服務單位，以「居家安老」及「持續照顧」的理念設計服務內容，讓有需要的長者得到全人照顧，以貼心的服務讓長者維持生活質素，安享晚年。

服務重點

為了配合長者需要和有更多的選擇，中心提供三種服務模式，分別為中心為本、家居為本、中心及家居為本的混合模式，讓長者及其家人按需要選擇合適的服務。

中心為本服務主要包括日間暫託服務，長者可在一個舒適的環境得到專業及適切的復康及護理服務；中心亦配置樂齡科技產品，為長者提供多樣化和富趣味性的活動，保持社交生活。家居為本服務包括由專業人員提供到戶式護理或復康運動服務；保健員或護理員提供個人護理、復康及認知訓練、護送及家居清潔等支援。此外，中心亦會為照顧者建立鄰里支援網絡，籌辦減壓活動以紓緩其照顧壓力，繼而妥善照顧家中長者。

Service Mission

Our Centre is a Recognised Service Provider under the “Community Care Service Voucher Scheme for the Elderly” of the Social Welfare Department. Based on the concepts of “Ageing in Place” and “Continuum of Care”, we provide professional services for the elderly in need so that they can receive whole-person care and continue to live in the community harmoniously.

Service Focus

To allow more flexibility for our service users, we provide three service modes including Centre-based, Home-based, and a mixed mode of Centre-based and Home-based. The elderly and their families can choose the appropriate service mode according to their unique needs.

The Centre-based services mainly include day care service for the elderly. They can receive professional and appropriate rehabilitation and nursing services in a comfortable environment. Our centre is equipped with gerontechnology products which provide a variety of interesting activities for the elderly to maintain their social life. Home-based services include home-based nursing or rehabilitation exercise services provided by professionals, personal care, rehabilitation and cognitive training, escort and household cleaning provided by health workers or care workers. In addition, we have also established a supportive network for the carers, organised stress-relief activities to relieve their caring stresses, and then took good care of the elderly at home.

The response was very positive. As reflected from the service statistics, users of Home-based services mostly requested for rehabilitation exercise and home care services.

Future development

With the regularisation of the “Community Care Service Voucher Scheme for the Elderly” on 1 September 2023, the number of service vouchers so as the potential service users will be increased. Our centre will continue to partner with the Pak U Neighbourhood Elderly Centre to strengthen the awareness of the elderly and their carers on the importance of self-health management and take preventive measures to maintain physical, mental, and spiritual health. Moreover, the centre launched the paid services since November 2023, allowing service users to purchase additional day care or home-based services based on their needs and financial situation.

**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2024**

1. General

New Territories Women & Juveniles Welfare Association Limited (the "Association") was incorporated in Hong Kong under the Companies Ordinance and is limited by guarantee. The liability of each member is limited to the extent of an amount not exceeding the sum of HK\$10. It is an approved charitable institution and is exempt from tax under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance. Its registered office and principal place of operation are at Room 401, 3/F., Yuen Long Town Hall, 4 Tai Yuk Road, Yuen Long, New Territories. The Association is engaged to promote, assist, encourage, improve, maintain or carry on any social welfare activities, family planning, recreation and the general health among the women, children and elderly in New Territories of HKSAR.

2. Basis of preparation

These financial statements are prepared in accordance with the Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard for Private Entities ("HKFRSPE") issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA"), and comply with the applicable requirements of the Companies Ordinance. The financial statements have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the Association is a going concern. In addition, historical cost convention is adopted.

3. Summary of significant accounting policies

Provided it is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the Association and the revenue and costs, if applicable, can be measured reliably, revenue is recognized as follows:

(a) Revenue recognition

- (i) Government grants and subventions other than grants received for acquisition of property, plant and equipment are recognized as income when no specified future performance conditions are imposed; if there are conditions, it is recognized as income when conditions are fulfilled.
- (ii) School fees and meal income are recognized when the right to receive the income is established.
- (iii) Program income are recognized upon provision of service.
- (iv) Donations and membership fee are recognized when the funds have been received.
- (v) Sales of inventories are recognized upon delivery of goods.
- (vi) Interest income is recognized as it accrues using the effective interest method.
- (vii) Government grants received for acquisition of property, plant and equipment are recognized over the period when the related assets are depreciated.

(b) Functional and presentation currency

The Association's functional and presentation currency is Hong Kong dollars.

3. Summary of significant accounting policies (continued)

(c) Cash and cash equivalents

For the purposes of the cash flow statement, cash and cash equivalents comprise cash on hand, and deposits with banks within 3 months to maturity from date of deposit.

(d) Impairment losses

At the end of each reporting period, property, plant and equipment are reviewed to determine whether there is any indication that those assets have suffered an impairment loss. If there is an indication of possible impairment, the recoverable amount of any affected asset (or group of related assets) is estimated and compared with its carrying amount. If estimated recoverable amount is lower, the carrying amount is reduced to its estimated recoverable amount, and an impairment is recognized immediately in surplus or deficit.

Similarly, at the end of each reporting period, inventories are assessed for impairment by comparing the carrying amount of each item of inventory (or group of similar items) with its selling price less costs to complete and sell. If an item of inventory (or group of similar items) is impaired, its carrying amount is reduced to selling price less costs to complete and sell, and an impairment loss is recognized immediately in surplus or deficit.

If an impairment loss subsequently reverses, the carrying amount of the asset (or group of related assets) is increased to the revised estimate of its recoverable amount, but not in excess of the amount that would have been determined had no impairment loss been recognized for the asset (or group of related assets) in prior years. A reversal of an impairment loss is recognized immediately in surplus or deficit.

(e) Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and any accumulated impairment losses.

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost of property, plant and equipment less accumulated impairment loss over their estimated useful lives using a straight line basis at the following rates:

Furniture, fixtures and equipment	25%
Computer hardware and software	25%
Leasehold improvements	33%

(f) Assets held under operating leases

Leases where substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership of assets remain with the lessor are accounted for as operating leases. Payments made under operating leases are charged to surplus or deficit on a straight line basis over the lease periods.

3. Summary of significant accounting policies (continued)

(g) Inventories

Inventories are stated at the lower of cost and net realizable value. Cost is determined on a first in first out basis. Net realizable value represents estimated selling price less all direct selling costs.

(h) Provisions

Provisions are recognized for liabilities of uncertain timing or amount when the Association has a present legal or constructive obligation as a result of past events, it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, and a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

(i) Account receivables and deposits

Account receivables and deposits are initially recognized at transaction price and at the end of reporting period are stated at amortized cost less impairment losses for bad and doubtful debts, unless the effect of discounting would be immaterial, in which case the receivables and deposits are stated at cost less impairment losses for bad and doubtful debts. A provision for impairment of receivables and deposits is made when there is objective evidence that the Association will not be able to collect all amounts due according to the original terms of receivables and deposits.

(j) Account payables and accruals

Accounts payable and accruals are initially recognized at transaction price and at the end of reporting period are stated at amortized cost unless the effect of discounting would be immaterial, in which case they are stated at cost.

(k) Related parties

For the purposes of these financial statements, related party includes a person and an entity as defined below:

(A) A person or a close member of that person's family is related to the Association if that person:

- (i) has control or joint control over the Association;
- (ii) has significant influence over the Association; or
- (iii) is a member of the key management personnel of the Association or of a parent of the Association.

(B) An entity is related to the Association if any of the following conditions applies:

- (i) The entity and the Association are members of the same group (which means that each parent, subsidiary and fellow subsidiary is related to the others).
- (ii) One entity is an associate or joint venture of the other entity (or an associate or joint venture of a member of a group of which the other entity is a member).

3. Summary of significant accounting policies (continued)

(k) Related parties (continued)

- (B) (iii) Both entities are joint ventures of the same third party.
- (iv) One entity is a joint venture of a third entity and the other entity is an associate of the third entity.
- (v) The entity is a post-employment benefit plan for the benefit of employees of either the Association or an entity related to the Association. If the Association is itself such a plan, the sponsoring employers are also related to the Association.
- (vi) The entity is controlled or jointly controlled by a person identified in (A).
- (vii) A person identified in (A)(i) has significant influence over the entity or is a member of the key management personnel of the entity (or of a parent of the entity).
- (viii) The entity, or any member of a group of which it is a part, provides key management personnel services to the Association or to the Association's parent.

Close members of the family of a person are those family members who may be expected to influence, or be influenced by, that person in their dealings with the entity.

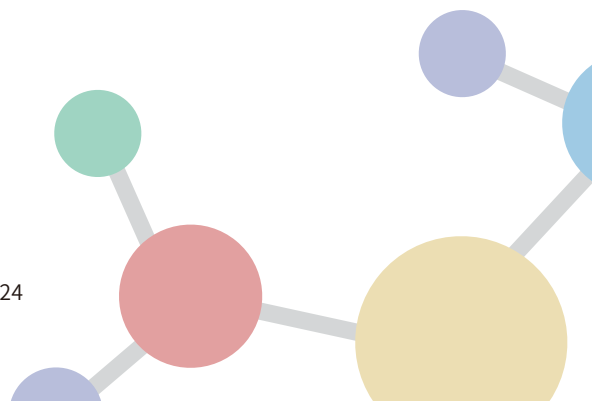
